CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MINOR CHILDREN INVOLVED IN PARISH PROGRAMS

The purchase, possession or consumption/use of alcoholic beverages or other illegal drugs will not be tolerated. Failure to comply will result in immediate dismissal from the event. This policy also applies to adult volunteers and chaperones.

Minors will not be allowed to smoke cigarettes or to use tobacco products, including chewing tobacco.

Participants are expected to obey the directions of adults in charge (catechists, youth group leaders, chaperones).

Participants are representing their parish community. Appropriate behavior and language are expected.

No dangerous or rough play will be tolerated.

Final decisions regarding acceptable behavior/consequences are the decision of the staff person in charge.

In general, if the behavior of a minor child results in his/her dismissal from the program, it is the responsibility of the parents/legal guardians to provide, at their own expense, transportation for the dismissed child. If a child is dismissed from an off site event and an adult chaperone must accompany the child home, the parents/legal guardian are responsible for any related expenses.

Attendance and participation at Faith Formation Programs

"We stand at an important moment in the life of the Church in our beloved Diocese. United with all who have gone before us in the living testimony of faith, we now have been given the opportunity to recommit our parishes, parish programs and parishioners to the sacramental life of the Church...."

We expect that regular participation in the programs will be a priority for all children and teens registered.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR CHILDREN

Bishop Salvatore Matano and the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis are implementing new guidelines for the preparation and celebration of sacraments in the Diocese of Rochester. Sacraments are celebrated in the parish community where the family is registered and attends Sunday mass.

Preparation for sacraments is separate and distinct from Catholic Schools or Faith Formation (Religious Education) Classes. Parents are involved in the preparation process.

Children must be enrolled in a formal program of Religion classes for one year prior to preparing for a sacrament.

Sacrament of Confirmation *Preparation begins after the completion of 7th Grade and includes a commitment to active involvement in the parish community (Celebration of Sunday Mass and the life of the community), ongoing growing in an understanding of our Catholic faith and service to others. Confirmation is celebrated during the Easter Season, ordinarily around the age of 15, at Sacred Heart Cathedral.*

Sacrament of First Penance *Preparation begins, ordinarily around the age of 7 (2nd grade), prior to the celebration of First Communion. First Penance is celebrated annually in the Advent season.*

Sacrament of First Communion *Preparation begins, ordinarily around the age of 7 (2nd grade), in January and First Communion is celebrated during the Easter Season.*
