**Ways to participate:**

1. Sign up to pray in front of the Blessed Sacrament: 10:00-10:30am at St. Boniface, 11:30-12:15pm at St. Mary's, 1:15 to 1:30pm at Blessed Sacrament
2. Walk with us in procession. Bringing the light of Christ into the streets and blessing our neighborhoods with the presence of Christ. We will need crossing guards, cross bearers, flag bearers, adult supervision of children a must. Process from St. Boniface to St. Mary's from 10:30-11:30 and/or from St. Mary's to Blessed Sacrament from 12:15-1:15.
3. Join the procession in prayer: Pray with us as we lift up agencies and establishments in our neighborhoods that help people who are poor have a more prosperous life. Prayer sheets will be available after the Masses.
4. Join us at two prayer stops along the route: ABVI-Goodwill parking lot at 422 S. Clinton Ave. at 10:45, or at Towner's Bikes at 190 Monroe Ave. at 12:30.
5. Help with refreshments: bake, setup, serve and/or clean up. See the sign up sheets at each church.
6. Work at the book sales table as we promote the sale of the Diocesan Anniversary History and Picture Book.
7. Photograph the event along the way and/or at each site.
8. Be a Good Samaritan and volunteer to shuttle people back to their cars.
9. Pray for nice weather and for the safety of those in the procession.
